Inside the temple on the main altar sits a huge bronze statue of Huyen Thien Tran Vu, measuring an imposing 4 meters high and weighing a spectacular 4 tons. The size and the fine details and owing to the expert craftsmanship of the bronze working from the 17th century has made this statue officially a national treasure. After the temple, as you continue along the lake side, you will walk past the memorial of John McCain, former Senator of the US and former US Navy pilot who was famously (infamously?) shot down as in Hanoi during wartime in 1967.

Following that, it would behoove you to take a leisurely stroll through the adjoining Presidential Palace. While sauntering through the garden you will catch a glimpse of some quaint scenes like a large, picturesque fish pond, the wooden house-on-stilts where Ho Chi Minh lived during his last years and the sturdy concrete house where he took his last breath. As you continue on your way out, be sure to visit the famous One-Pillar Pagoda made in the likeness of Guanyin, a goddess in Chinese mythology who is the goddess of mercy and compassion.

After the temple, as you continue along the lake side, you will walk past the memorial of John McCain, former Senator of the US and former US Navy pilot who was famously (infamously?) shot down as in Ha Noi during wartime in 1967.

After lunch the tour continues. Next stop is the Temple of Literature and the attached Noble Academy replete with beautifully restored architecture meant to preserve the history of Vietnam's imperial education. A highlight in the complex is the collection of stone stelae bearing names of the successful mandarin examinees throughout many, many centuries. Tour continues around the illustrious Sword Lake. On a little island within the lake sits Ngoc Son Temple and is connected to the bank by the The Huc Bridge conspicuously painted in red. Ngoc Son Temple was built in honor of the eminent military leader and tactician, Tran Hung Dao. After that, why not mosey on over to the Old Quarter nearby and explore the buzzing sights and sounds and smells of the shophouses, food stalls and friendly pubs to wet your whistle!

Finally in the late afternoon, you'll enter the water puppet theater to see the scintillating yet quaint performance of this ancient and uniquely Vietnamese art form that's been performed since the 11th century.

# HA LONG BAY

After lunch, the ship will be underway and you will find yourself at the gaping maws of two adjacent caves, Thien Cung and Dau Go (the latter of which being the biggest cave in Ha Long Bay). Have your camera at the ready as these caves contain stunning natural beauty like the curious stalagmites and stalactites in the shapes of animals as well as numerous types of fauna flying, climbing and slithering around. When you've had your fill of caves for the day, the ship will take you back to shore where your driver will then take you back to your hotel.

First, your local guide and driver will take you across the Red River toward the southern bank of Duong River where But Thap Pagoda is located. The pagoda is among the most famous and valuable Buddhist monuments around Ha Noi and has undergone multiple renovations since the 17th century. Visit the pagoda to contemplate the well-built timber frame architecture along with numerous multicentury old wood statues and sculptures. The most notable vestige in the pagoda is the stone stupa which dates back to the Tran period around the 13-14th century. According to history, King Tu Duc came to the pagoda in 1876 and saw the Bao Nghiem tower and likened it to a huge pen pointing to the sky and subsequently called it "But Thap" (Pen Tower).

Next on the list is a drive to nearby Dong Ho village, renowned as the birthplace of the wood block painting art from centuries ago. The trade is now vanishing but you will visit the preservation center where you can study the meticulous working processes and behold the finished products of this now-rare artform. The paintings are of various subjects; some paintings are of traditional scenes and some are infused with modern life elements.



Following that is yet another brief drive to reach Bat Trang village, the most famous and among the oldest pottery villages in the Red River Delta. Once in this breezy and tranquil village you are at liberty to meander up and down the charming country roads and take photos until your heart's content! After that, don't forget to casually saunter to the marketplace in the center of the village. Here you can find an almost innumerable multitude of shops selling fine Bat Trang produced wares. You can also visit an old kiln or play with the potter's wheel and pretend you're either Patrick Swayze or Demi Moore from that one movie... After all the fun and games, your driver will return you to your hotel.

## **DUONG LAM VILLAGE**

The village is a superb place to saunter around to take in the scenes of an ancient, bygone era like the ornamental rooflines and worn brick lanes. ## **NINH BINH**



Next is a brief transfer to the boat dock nearby where you'll then embark on a motorboat for a scenic trip to the diminutive yet charming mountain commune of Thung Nai. You'll visit a colorful temple where the locals pay homage to a Goddess who patronizes the fishermen in Thung Nai.

Leaving Thung Nai you'll take the road toward Mai Chau valley and all the while stop briefly at certain vista points hill side to experience sensational panoramic views of the flat green valley below. The tour continues the remaining distance to one of the ethnic Thai minority villages in the valley for a rustic and warm homestay experience. You are advised to make yourself at home and say hello to your new neighbors! After dinner, you are free to stroll around in the village at your leisure.







#### D2: Mai Chau - Ha Noi (B/L)

The hike goes through artificial flower gardens and interesting natural rock formations. And at the peak platform, you can take in a scenic view of the town and of the mysterious 3,143 meter Fansipan mountain peak far in the distance across Muong Hoa valley.

Finally you'll check into your hotel. In the evening, you are free to explore your new surroundings in the town.



#### D2: Sapa (B/L)

The whole day is for you to explore the beautiful landscape of Sapa and to gain an intimate insight of the minority lifestyle. First, you'll go to the train station and take a scenic train ride that goes across the breathtaking landscape of Muong Hoa valley. The train stops at the terminal which also happens to be the starting point of the Fansipan mountain cable car.



You'll take the cable ride up to reach the peak complex where you may witness some of the most spectacular views in all directions provided the views are not blocked by the thickness of the clouds. There are pagodas, stupas, Buddha statues on the peak complex, all connected by step trails. If you're up to the task, you can hike and ultimately reach the 3,143 meter point marking the peak of Fansipan. Go for it!

Once you've had enough of hiking in the clouds you'll hop on the cable car again and come back down the mountain. The exploration continues with a visit to the Silver Falls and Tram Ton Pass. At the Silver Falls, follow the pretty steps up to see the mighty falls. At Tram Ton Pass, you'll surely have some thrills with the eye-popping glass floor on the sky walkway! And after all that excitement you'll transfer back to town where you'll be free for the rest of the day.

#### D3: Sapa - Ha Noi (B/L)





## Full-day Trek at

## **BACH MA NATIONAL PARK**

The trek at Bach Ma National Park is a fascinating experience for nature lovers with a decent degree of fitness (spoiler alert: you'll be walking for a while). You'll begin the tour by leaving Hue and being driven south toward Bach Ma mountain approximately 41 km south. You'll enter the National Park and take the 15km scenic drive uphill toward the station where, in 1932, the Morin family company (Société en nom collectif Morin Frère) built a hill resort for recreation. Today the old villas are still in use to provide basic accommodation and also serve as the base for the treks.



Up next is the arduous trek that follows Ngu Ho Trail and takes roughly 3 hours to loop back. The trail guides you through lush, green primeval jungles and winds along a creek which gently flows through a series of five cascades until you reach Do Quyen Falls. The waterfall boasts a stunning height of 300 meters which gives quite a thrill when standing atop the falls facing towards the vast opening in front. You'll continue the hike and eventually loop back around to the station.

After lunch you'll take a short walk up to the peak platform which marks the 1,444 meter elevation above sea level and offers spectacular views of the verdant coastal lowlands. Lastly, you'll hike back to the Morin station where you'll begin your journey back to Hue.








## **HUE - PHONG NHA - HUE**

(2 Days 1 Night)



#### D1: Hue to Phong Nha (L/D)

The tour begins with a drive north along Route 1A (210km/4.5hrs) through coastal plains, passing country towns, rice fields, rivers and mountains. Suggested by the name which means "paradise" or "heavenly" this cave boasts a gigantic interior space and a magnificent speleothem system including spectacular stalactites. After the visit and experiencing the otherworldly splendor of Phong Nha, you'll begin the journey back to Hue city.

The monotony of the road trip will be broken up by a stop at Ben Hai River and the DMZ memorial (120km), both of which marked the 17th Parallel or the war-time demilitarized zone between the opposing North and South Vietnam. Today the old steel bridge is kept as a monument, with each half painted in a different color.



You may take your time to take pictures of this landmark before continuing the drive toward Hue.

Before entering Hue, you'll have yet another stop but this time to the pottery village of Phuoc Tich. You'll be invited to stroll around this peaceful, 500 year old village where the authentic rural atmosphere has been well preserved and is replete with quiet lanes and old, cozy houses. After a tasty lunch in Chau Doc, you'll visit the colorful Tay An Pagoda, the burial place of the much venerated Buddhist master Doan Minh Huyen who founded the sect of Buu Son Ky Huong and made a profound influence on the locals. The pagoda also boasts a large collection of priceless statues and figurines.



The sightseeing experience in Chau Doc continues! You'll be driven out of town to Tra Su flooded forest. In Tra Su, you'll be treated to a very scenic boat ride to explore the protected nature and for bird encounters. Watch swarms of birds flying back to the natural park by sunset. Finally you will be driven back to town to spend the night .

#### D3: Chau Doc - HCM City (B/L)

You'll leave Chau Doc in the morning and head back toward Ho Chi Minh City. En route, you'll stop at Sa Dec to visit the flower village. Sa Dec has long been famous with the trade of growing flowers, bonsais and ornamental plants. You may saunter along the main road or happily meander about with an electric car as an alternative. You can drop into any garden you like to see the plants or to take pictures as the locals are extremely friendly and welcoming. There are a couple of gardens which require a fee for entrance and use of their facilities such as a watchtower, the photo corners, or for the fish feeding show. After the visit, you'll continue the journey toward Ho Chi Minh City.

The statue resembles that of another Christ statue located in Corcovado, Rio de Janeiro. If you have time and feel fit enough, you're more than welcome to hike up 700 plus stone steps to the hilltop. Next to the feet of Christ and flanking on both sides are two imposing cannons pointing toward the bay, giving an odd juxtaposition of the Prince of Peace flanked by two weapons of war.

After the visit to Vung Tau, you'll take the next 50 km drive on the scenic coastal road to Ho Tram by going along a series of sand strips. Once in Ho Tram you'll then check into one of the luxury resorts.



#### D2: Ho Tram (B)

#### D3: Ho Tram - HCM City (B)


